

Project Development and Implementation Internship with IOM Budapest (Hungarian speaking)

The International Organization for Migration (IOM) Project Development and Implementation Unit (PDIU) is seeking one Project Development and Implementation Intern for a full-time, three- or six-month commitment to work at the IOM Office in Budapest starting on 01st August 2016. Internship positions are unpaid.

Responsibilities:

- 1) Assist with conceptualization, drafting, and editing project proposals;
- 2) Assist with preparing and finalizing project proposal submission packages to donors;
- 3) Assist with implementation of projects, including assistance with publications, conferences and other events:
- 4) Contribute to IOM's media campaigns and online presence;
- 5) Assist in administrative tasks, such as note-taking, writing reports of projects, drafting letters, filing, etc;
- 6) Perform any other duties as requested.

Requirements:

- 1) A degree in a relevant field, such as international relations, sociology, political science or law;
- 2) Strong research and analytical skills;
- 3) Experience and/or proven interest in migration issues;
- 4) Excellent spoken and written English and Hungarian required;
- 5) Knowledge of Arabic, Farsi, Pashtu or French is a distinct advantage;
- 6) Experience with writing project proposals or fundraising is a distinct advantage;
- 7) Experience of proofing and/or editing an asset:
- 8) Attention to detail, good communication and interpersonal skills;
- 9) Experience with an international organization or an NGO desirable.
